LA MAGA

La Maga is a Peruvian singer based in Germany, whose music weaves Afro-Peruvian roots with Latin American traditions, shaped by the experience of migration and distance from home. Her artistic path began in Lima, where singing was already a central part of her life. Living in Germany later led her to reconnect deeply with her cultural roots, transforming nostalgia into a creative force. Singing in Spanish within the German cultural context, her voice becomes a cultural bridge — offering celebration, memory and a sense of belonging.

Her repertoire is rooted in Afro-Peruvian rhythms — with the *landó* as a central element — alongside Peruvian Creole music and selected Latin American genres such as *cumbia*. Through original compositions and carefully chosen traditional songs, La Maga addresses themes of memory, migration, identity and community, carried by a warm, powerful voice and an expressive live presence.
